PRODUCTION

In 2021/22 EGGER UK produced over 1.1 million m³ of chipboard

Hexham's Energy Plant saves **67,000 tonnes of CO₂ per year** by burning unusable wood residue rather than natural gas

Emissions to air are regulated and routinely monitored

PRODUCTS

In the UK we produce:

- Raw Chipboard
- Eurodekor Faced Chipboard
- Structural Chipboard Flooring

Made using recycled wood. (40%) by-products from the sawmill (40%) and virgin fibre (20%)

Chipboard is

100% recyclable and carbon negative



Carbon is stored for the lifetime of a board
