

Manufacturer's Declaration on the Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive (RoHS)

The RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) directive 2002/95/EC was adopted in February 2003 by the European Union and replaced by 2011/65/EU (RoHS II). This directive restricts the use of various hazardous substances in the manufacture of various types of electronic and electrical equipment. The allowed concentrations refer to the homogenous materials not to the finished product. This declaration includes the delegated act (EU) 2015/863.
