

## Technical leaflet

### EGGER Laminate Flooring, Comfort Flooring and Design Flooring

#### Waste disposal

EGGER Laminate Flooring, Comfort Flooring and Design Flooring remains from construction site as well as those from demolition activities, should be carried, first and foremost, to a recycling centre. If this is not possible, no longer usable laminate flooring remains, Comfort Flooring and Design Flooring remains must be used for the production of process energy and electricity (cogeneration) instead of being stored because of the high heating value of approx. 16MJ/kg (waste disposal key according to European waste catalogue: 170201/030103).

If a consumer takes the flooring to a municipal disposal or mixed bulky waste centre, this is categorized according to key numbers 200138 (sorted disposal) or 200307 (bulky waste) for municipal waste. According to this waste disposal key a thermal recycling (recycling center or direct thermal power station) would also be possible. A landfill with for example construction waste is anywhere Europe not allowed.
