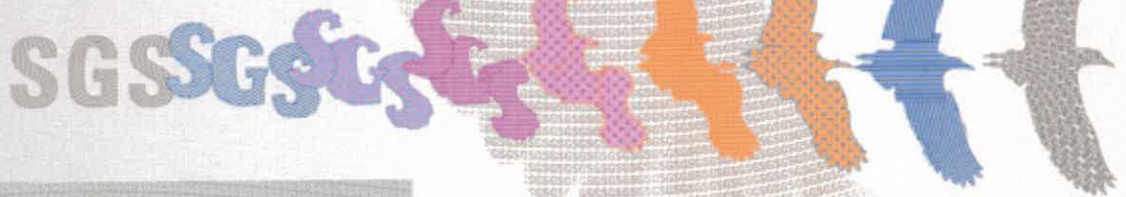

The purchase FSC Mix fibreboard and particle board and FSC Mix and FSC Controlled Wood paper, for the production and sale of FSC Mix fibreboard products, using the credit system with the outsourcing of bonding, cutting edging foiling and coating processes.

The purchase, storage, processing and sales of FSC Mix particle board and fibreboard products, using the transfer system.
